The purpose of the additional PWC meetings in 2023 is to provide an opportunity for the public to interact with the PWC and provide comments on the draft wolf reintroduction and management plan. The majority of the meetings will be for PWC members to ask questions of CPW staff and to listen to public testimony on the plan.
