COLORADO'S HUNTING HERITAGE UNDER THREAT (and this is everyone's battle)

In the past five years, there have been numerous attempts to curtail the hunting of Colorado Mountain Lions and Bobcats. Now, with Proposed Initiative 91, the stakes are even higher. This initiative seeks to let Colorado voters determine the future of science-based wildlife management, potentially undermining the authority of Colorado's Wildlife Managers (CPW) and the rights of sportsmen and women. Misleading language, such as "Trophy Hunting," is being used to sway public opinion. This isn't just about fair chase or management concerns; it's a deliberate attempt to misinform.
